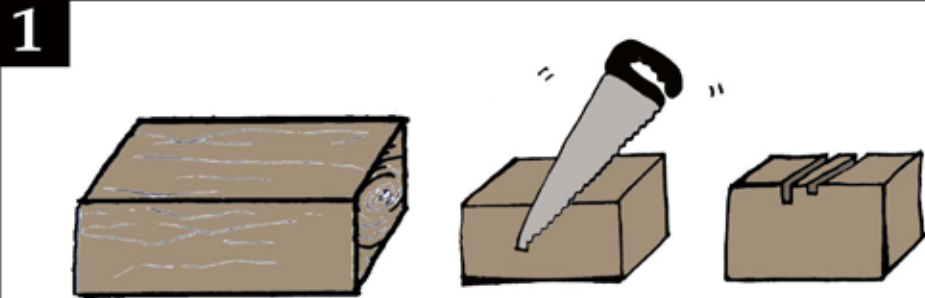
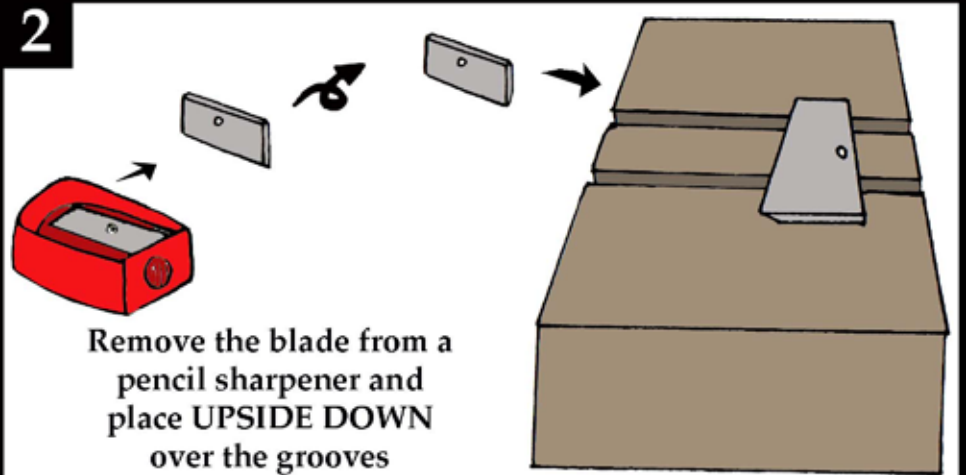


How to Make a Bottle Cutter

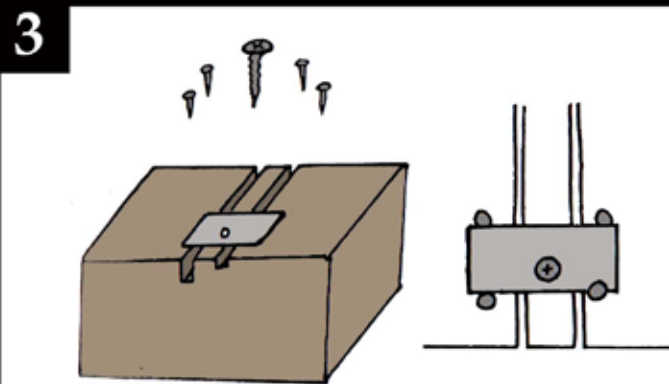

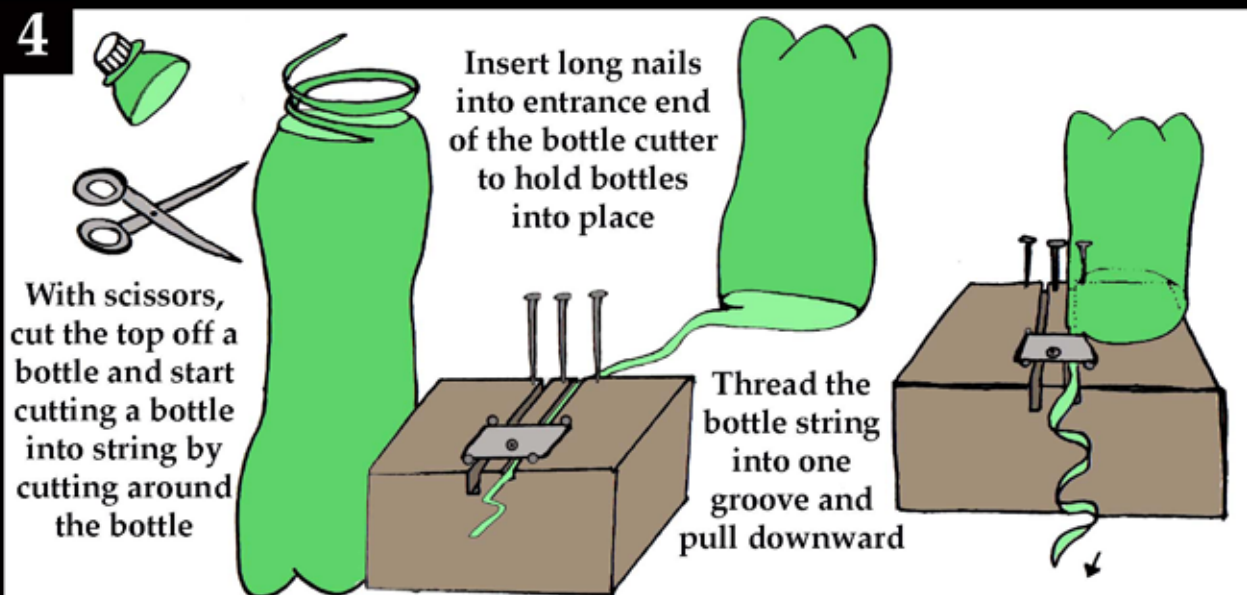
Saw one or two narrow grooves into a block of wood. The depth of the groove will indicate the width of the bottle string



Remove the blade from a pencil sharpener and place UPSIDE DOWN over the grooves



Screw and/or nail the blade into place. It should be flat and secure



Insert long nails into entrance end of the bottle cutter to hold bottles into place

With scissors, cut the top off a bottle and start cutting a bottle into string by cutting around the bottle

Thread the bottle string into one groove and pull downward
